
INFORMATION ABOUT THE SURVEY

- This national representative survey was conducted from July 31 to August 10, 2006.
- 1,200 Armenian residents (voters) aged 18 years and over were interviewed face-to-face. The margin of error does not exceed 3 percent.
- The survey was carried out on behalf of IRI.
- It was funded by the United States Agency for International Development. The study was designed, coordinated and analyzed by Baltic Surveys/The Gallup Organization (Dr. R.Alisauskiene).
- The fieldwork was carried out by the Armenian Sociological Association (ASA).

Mood of the country: 62 percent of Armenians think that the country is on the wrong track, while 31 percent think that the country is going in the right direction






Mood of the country: 39 percent of Armenians see improvement in the country's economy, while 21 percent think it is declining

Over the last 12 months, the economic situation in Armenia has ...




Mood of the country: 26 percent of Armenians say their household's financial situation has improved, while 24 percent say it has declined

Over the last 12 months, the financial situation of your household has...




Mood of the country: 29 percent of Armenians are satisfied with the development of democracy, while 68 percent are not

How satisfied are you with the way democracy is developing in Armenia?




Mood of the country: An overall majority of Armenians think that it will take a long time to improve things in their country


Do you believe that things will get better in a short time, or will it take a long time for things to get better in the country?












Most important issues facing Armenia. August 2006 (response in %)




Most important issue facing towns/villages in Armenia. May 2006 (%)




Most important issue facing towns/villages in Armenia. August 2006 (%)



Most important issue facing households in Armenia. May 2006 (%)






Issues

- At the national level, social problems and territorial integrity/security issues are most important.


Acceptability of forms of social protest May 2006 (%)




Acceptability of forms of social protest August 2006 (%)




The biggest fears are related to instability/security: territorial integrity of the country, war and social instability, unemployment, social-economic problems.


What should the Armenian government do first of all to attract the support of the majority of the Armenian population? May 2006 (%)




What should the Armenian government do first of all to attract the support of the majority of the Armenian population? August 2006 (%)






Why do you plan to vote? (Planning to vote %)
















Most liked features of Armenian politicians or parties (%)




Most disliked features of Armenian politicians or parties (%)




Major mistakes and failures of Armenian authorities over the last year. May 2006 (%)



Major mistakes and failures of Armenian authorities over the last year. August 2006 (%)








Which countries are the most important partners for Armenia?

And which comprise the greatest political and economic threat?
























Is a "colored revolution" – like what happened in other Commonwealth of Independent States countries – likely in Armenia? (%)








Should Armenia in the future... August 2006 (%)










VALUES OF ARMENIAN PEOPLE, May 2006 (Mean scores, 1 - "Important to me," 9 - "Most important to me")




VALUES OF ARMENIAN PEOPLE. August, 2006 (Mean scores, 1 - "Important to me," 9 - "Most important to me")






Sources of political information (%)




Sources of information in election campaign May 2006 (%)






How fraudulent was the referendum of 2005? (10 - very fraudulent, 1 - not at all fraudulent)








How fraudulent will the upcoming Parliamentary elections be?
